Agenda Item VI – Futures in Management Institutes	Members discussed an invitation to the Council to jointly sponsor a Futures in Management Institute with First 5 Sacramento, SCOE and Child Action, Inc. While no monies were requested, members did ask if the Council had funds to support the event. Members asked if anyone had attended the institute to which one member responded with a yes, though they did not feel the event met their expectations. Members expressed concern about the quality of the event and requested more information on the Institute, such as names of presenters, testimonies from those who have attended in the past and specifics on resources, including Program Administrative Scale materials. Staff advised members that Doreen Diehl, First 5 Sacramento, is available to attend the January meeting and provide an overview of the Institute. Natalie Woods Andrews, SCOE, noted the opportunity to collaborate in this effort underscores the professional development each of the participating agencies has supported in recent years. Members agreed to move the item to the agenda for the Council's January meeting for a presentation and further discussion.
